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## **Applying for <u>Licensure</u> in NYS for Mental Health Counselors**

Applying for your mental health counseling **licensure** can be a confusing process. This guide hopefully can provide some additional detail to help.

- 1. Your main source for information/forms is the NYS Office of the Professions
  - Familiarize yourself with the <u>checklist</u>, <u>requirements for licensure</u> and <u>FAQs</u>
- 2. Take the National Clinical Mental Health Counselor Exam (NCMHCE).
  - <u>NBCC website</u> for information, some preparation material, and registration (check <u>handbook</u> for details).
    - The registration site is <u>ProCounselor</u>. Once approved you can schedule an exam date with PearsonVUE.
  - You can use this site for preparation <u>Counselingexam.com</u>.
  - After passing the exam make sure you instruct NBCC to send the examination score verification to the NYS office.
    - If you give yourself at least 4 weeks time before your hours are complete and begin submitting for your full license the cost will be cheaper. There is a 2 day more expensive option.

Once you are approaching 3,000 hours of experience (at least half being direct client hours)

- 3. Refer to the <u>Checklist</u> which will show you the forms needed to fully submit for your license (check the descriptions on the website for additional details)
  - Fully submitted Form 1 along with the \$371 licensure and first registration fee.
  - Form 4 Applicant Experience and Endorsement Record
    - Complete both pages and sign/date item 9
    - You may include your hours tracker/log with this form.
    - Send to the Office of Professions address at the end of the form.
  - Form 4B Certification of Supervised Experience
    - Complete Section I.
    - Forward entirety of Form 4B to supervisor along with Appendix A to each supervisor(s) listed in item 8 of Form 4.
    - **The supervisor(s)** will send it to the Office of Professions address at the end of the form. They will not accept this form if submitted by the applicant.
- 4. Refer to the <u>website</u>, <u>requirements for licensure</u> and <u>FAQs</u> to ensure everything is correct and complete. If there are any inconsistencies, it will delay the processing of your licensure application.

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- 5. After you have submitted all your documentation, please allow 6 weeks before submitting a Contact Us Form to request a status update.
